Firstly, we had a target to increase the amount raised by 20% compared to what we did in 2022 (which was approx. 40K+). We do this because we want to do more for our

Secondly, doing good through corporate social responsibility (CSR) has become more habitual for most people and this is a great devicement. Yet this also means many of the denors are already actively contributing to other CSR efforts outside of Great Eastern Whemen's Plan.

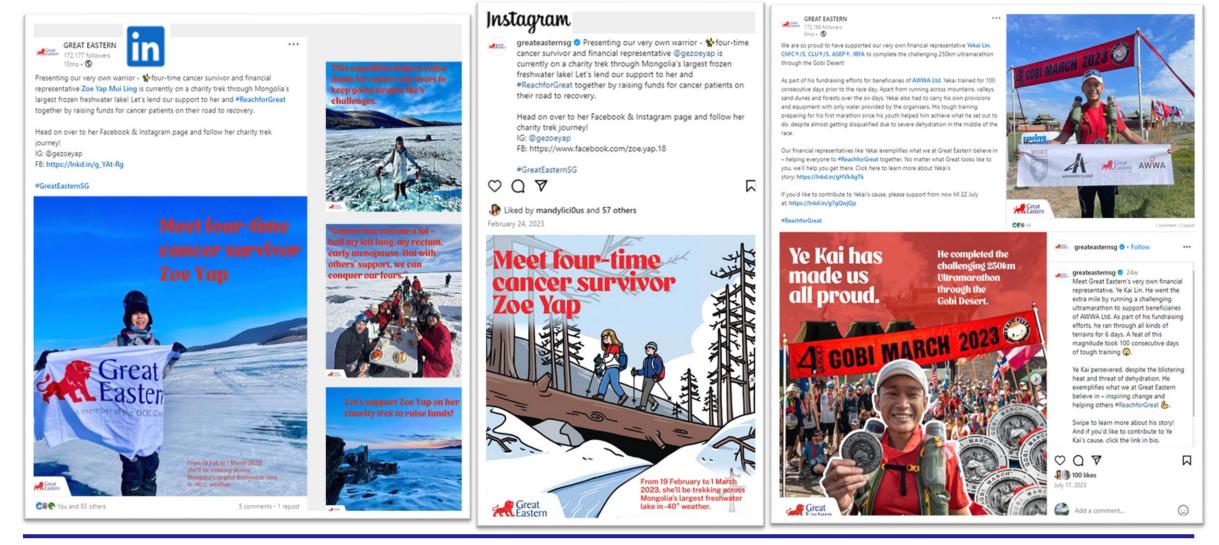
