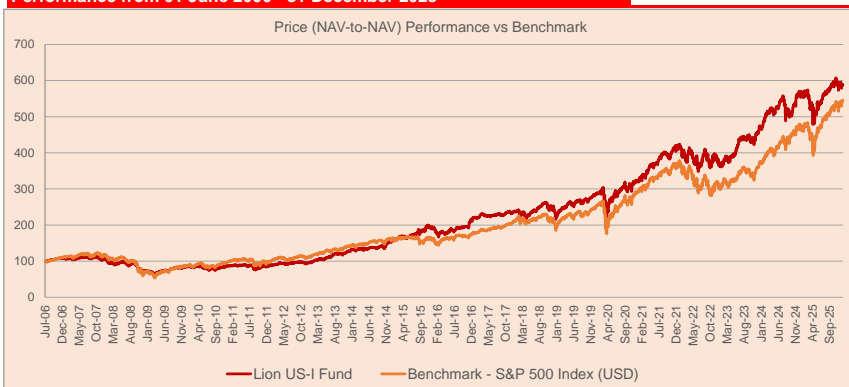


**Fund Objective**

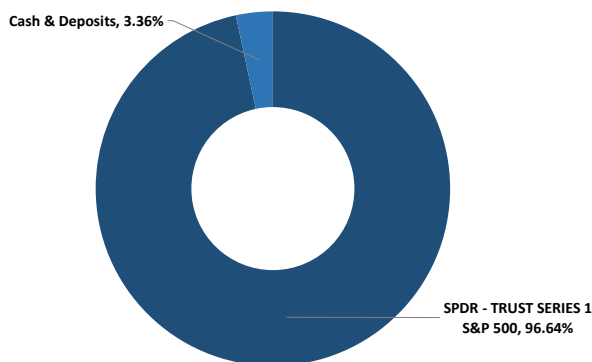

**Equity****Market Review**

The KLCI 4.7% in December 2025, outperforming the MSCI ASEAN index, and ended 2025 up 2.3% in local currency terms (12.8% in USD) at 1,680. Utilities and Materials are best performing sectors. On the flipside, IT, Telecom, and Consumer Discretionary lagged. Market breadth broadened to 24/6 advancers/decliner in December vs. 13/17 previous month. Average daily traded volume slumped by 21% MoM to US\$549 million during holiday season. Foreign investors net sold US\$502 million of Malaysia stocks in December.

**Market Outlook**

The KLCI 4.7% in December 2025, outperforming the MSCI ASEAN index, and ended 2025 up 2.3% in local currency terms (12.8% in USD) at 1,680. Utilities and Materials are best performing sectors. Key index performances in the U.S. were mixed, where the Dow Jones gained 0.7% MoM, the S&P 500 was flattish MoM (-3 points MoM), and the Nasdaq eased by 0.5% MoM. The Dow Jones index was underpinned by broad blue-chip strength, while the Nasdaq was impacted by tech stocks easing towards the month end.
