Great Malaysia Pickleball Cup Contest - Terms and Conditions

Eligibility

The Organiser may also disclose the personal data under the requirements of any law, rules, regulations, codes of practice or guidelines binding on the Organiser including, without limitation, any applicable regulators, governmental bodies and where otherwise required by law.

By participating in this Contest, participants are taken to have read, understood and agreed to be bound by these Terms and Conditions, and accept that all decisions by the Organiser are final and binding. - 25. Failure or delay by the Organiser to enforce any provision of these Terms and Conditions shall not constitute to a waiver of that provision.
- 26. These terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Malaysia.
