Campaign Overview

1. What is Medic Guard Campaign 2.0?

Medic Guard Campaign 2.0 (“Campaign”) offers Selected Customer (refer to Question 7 below) who currently has an active medical policy as per the listed medical plan(s)/rider(s) (“Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s)”) (refer to Question 8 below) the opportunity to apply for a new **SmartProtect You Exclusive (SPYE)** policy with a medical rider, **GREAT MediValue Exclusive with RM20,000 deductible per policy year that comes with The Great Journey pathway (GMVE)**.

Through this Campaign, the new medical riders offer enhanced medical benefits **without requiring medical underwriting and the waiting period will be waived***, while allowing you to maintain your existing medical plan.

*Waiting period will continue to be applicable in the new medical rider if the waiting period has not yet passed in your existing medical plan.

The Company reserves the right, at its sole and absolute discretion, to amend these terms and conditions at any time without prior notice, provided such changes fall within the Company's risk appetite, and such decisions shall be final and binding.

- i. Coverage for TPD is only applicable for TPD that occurs prior to the policy anniversary on which the life assured attains age 75 years next birthday.
- ii. Any health loadings and/or exclusions applied to your Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) will be applied to your new GMVE.
- iii. Pre-existing illness – disabilities or conditions related to 50 critical illnesses (refer to table (vi) below), spinal disorders, or diabetes and its complications that have been diagnosed, disclosed, or claimed prior to the risk effective date of the new policy will **not** be covered.
- iv. For other pre-existing conditions (not listed in (iii) above), coverage will be **excluded**:
 - if the conditions have been diagnosed, disclosed, or claimed prior to the risk effective date of the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s); and
 - for the first 3 policy years commencing from the risk effective date of the new policy where such conditions have been diagnosed, disclosed or claimed at any time from the risk effective date of the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) up to the risk effective date of the new policy. Coverage for these conditions shall commence from the 4th policy year onwards.
- v. If there is a break in coverage after the risk effective date of GMVE, the same terms and conditions for pre-existing conditions as stated in (iii) and (iv) above will apply again from the reinstatement date, which shall be deemed the risk effective date of the new policy for this purpose.

2. What is the offer period of the Campaign?

The Campaign is available for a limited period from 1 June 2026 to 30 June 2026 (both days inclusive). Application must be submitted within the stipulated period and the Company will not accept any application submitted outside of the stipulated period. Each Selected Customer is entitled to submit only one (1) application under this Campaign. If multiple applications are received from the same Selected Customer, all additional applications will be rejected. For assistance with the enrolment process, kindly contact your servicing agent or the Company, if you do not have a servicing agent.

3. Should I maintain my Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s)?

This Campaign is designed to provide you an affordable and hassle-free solution to enhance your medical protection. As the new policy comes with a high-deductible feature and excludes certain pre-existing conditions (refer to Question 1 above), maintaining your Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) will ensure continuous and comprehensive protection.

By having both the policies, your Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) will continue to cover medical expenses as usual. Once its benefits are exhausted (or not available under the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s)) and the deductible and/or co-insurance under the new policy is considered fulfilled by the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s), provided that the admitting disability(ies) or condition(s) are eligible under both the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) and the new GMVE. The new policy will step in to cover remaining eligible costs up to the applicable limits of GMVE, subject to the terms and conditions of The Great Journey pathway. Please note that claims under the new GMVE will be subject to standard review process. **You may refer to Question 38 and Appendix below for some claims scenarios.**

In this respect, you may consult your servicing agent to review your insurance coverage and benefits in accordance with your needs and select the best option that suits you.

4. What happens if my Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) has been terminated due to the lifetime limit is fully exhausted? How will the subsequent admissions be covered under GMVE?

If your Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) is terminated due to the lifetime limit is fully exhausted, you will need to pay up to RM20,000 deductible under GMVE for any future hospital admissions. GMVE will only start paying the remaining eligible expenses after the deductible is met, and all claims are still subject to the benefit's limits, terms and conditions of The Great Journey pathway and exclusions on the pre-existing coverage.

5. What will happen to my Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) after I have applied for the SPYE + GMVE under this Campaign?

Your Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) including all secondary medical riders, will remain in force. There will be no impact on the benefits of the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s). The new policy will serve as an additional layer of protection, enhancing your current medical coverage and helping to cover medical expenses that may exceed your current coverage limit.

6. I applied for SPYE + GMVE under this Campaign but later terminated the policy. Will this affect my Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s)?

No, terminating SPYE + GMVE will not affect your Existing Medical Plan(s) / Rider(s).

Campaign Eligibility

7. Who is eligible for this Campaign?

Only customers who received the offer letter (“Selected Customer”) are eligible for this Campaign.

8. Which medical plan/riders are eligible for this Campaign?

This Campaign is available for the selected withdrawn medical plans/riders listed below:

9. How do I know if I am selected for the offer in this Campaign?

You will receive an SMS/WhatsApp/email notification regarding this offer. If you are an e-Connect user, you may view/download the offer letter in e-Connect under **My Document >> Important Notification**. Your servicing agent will have a copy of your offer letter too, which outlines the products you are eligible for and the validity period. If you are not an e-Connect user, please sign up at <https://econnect-my.greatasteasternlife.com>. You are strongly encouraged to sign up for an e-Connect account as e-Connect is a dedicated portal for our customers to view their insurance portfolio, perform selected transactions online and check the status of their claims.

10. If I am not a Selected Customer, can I apply to the Company for SPYE + GMVE under this Campaign?

No, the offer in this Campaign is offered to the Selected Customers only. However, if you were not selected or if you were selected but did not apply for the new policy within the offer period of the Campaign, you can enrol to GREAT MediValue via the usual enrolment process through your servicing agent. Medical underwriting will be required, and standard waiting period shall apply.

11. If I do not accept the offer under this Campaign within the offer period, will my eligibility for this Campaign or the medical rider offering under it change in any subsequent offer under the same Campaign?

Yes, both your eligibility for the Campaign and your medical rider offering under this Campaign may change based on your claim history, in any subsequent offer under the same Campaign if you did not accept the offer within the offer period. The Company reserves the right to review your eligibility for this Campaign to adjust the medical rider offering from time to time, in accordance with the Company's acceptable risk parameters. This means that you may no longer be eligible for the Campaign after the offer period ends, or your medical rider offering could be different from what was initially offered. 12. I received the offer letter for this Campaign, but my husband did not. Why is he not eligible?

This Campaign is only offered to Selected Customers who fulfil the Company's pre-determined criteria. However, customers who were not selected may enrol to GREAT MediValue via the usual enrolment process through your servicing agent. Medical underwriting will be required, and standard waiting period shall apply.

13. I have received the offer letter for this Campaign. However, my Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) is currently under premium waived status. Am I still eligible for this Campaign?

No, this Campaign is only available to policies under non-premium waived status. If your policy status changes between the data extraction date and the mailing date of the offer letter, it no longer fulfils the pre-determined selection criteria and your eligibility for this Campaign will be voided.

Campaign Offer

14. What is the minimum and maximum entry age of SPYE + GMVE?

The minimum entry age is 14 days attained age and the maximum entry age is 70 years next birthday.

15. What are the deductible options available for the new unit deducting medical rider under this Campaign?

There is only one (1) deductible option of RM20,000 per policy year available for GMVE in this Campaign.

16. What is the Overall Annual Limit for the new unit deducting medical rider under this Campaign?

GMVE offers an Overall Annual Limit of RM500,000 in this Campaign.

17. What is the Room & Board (R&B) options available for the new unit deducting medical rider in this Campaign?

There is only one (1) R&B option of RM200 available for GMVE, regardless of the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) R&B option, as shown in the table below:

18. What is The Great Journey pathway under SPYE + GMVE? How does it work?

The Great Journey pathway is a redefined healthcare journey designed to deliver high-quality and cost-effective care through a trusted network of healthcare providers, comprising of The Great Journey Clinics and The Great Journey Hospitals. Customers will begin their care at The Great Journey Clinics and when necessary, be seamlessly connected to The Great Journey Hospitals for further treatment. Customers who seek treatment within The Great Journey network may receive additional support and value-added services to enhance their experience.

3. **Co-insurance of 20% (up to RM20,000 per policy year) is applicable on top of the RM20,000 deductible if the life assured does not completely follow the designated medical pathway under The Great Journey.** Please refer to The Great Journey webpage, Product Disclosure Sheet and policy contract for further details.

19. Is medical underwriting required to apply for SPYE + GMVE offered under this Campaign? Is there any waiting period?

No, this Campaign offers guaranteed acceptance with no medical underwriting for Selected Customers. Furthermore, waiting periods are waived provided your Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) have passed their waiting periods. Otherwise, waiting period will continue to be applicable in the new medical rider for the remaining term if the waiting period has not yet passed in your Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s).

Proposal Application

20. How do I apply for SPYE + GMVE under this Campaign?

Please contact your servicing agent or the Company for a detailed quotation and information on the new policy application and to assist you through the enrolment process.

21. When will the SPYE + GMVE coverage take effect?

The coverage will take effect once your application is accepted and in force.

22. Does the application for SPYE + GMVE through this Campaign require an additional premium?

Yes, you will need to pay the new premium amount for the new policy as specified in the Sales Illustration provided by your servicing agent. Please note that the loadings applied on your Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) will also be applied to your new GMVE rider. The additional premium as a result of loadings (Great Saver Rider (GSR)) will be notified via Letter of Conditional Acceptance after your policy submission.

23. If my occupation class was Class 2 under Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) and the occupation class is changed to Class 4 upon purchase of SPYE + GMVE through this Campaign, will SPYE + GMVE premiums be charged based on latest occupation class (i.e.: Class 4)?

Yes, SPYE + GMVE premiums will be charged based on latest occupation class upon purchase of the new policy.

24. How are insurance charges applied to my policy?

Insurance charges are deducted monthly from the value of your units. These charges typically increase as you grow older. Please note that insurance charges are non-guaranteed and may be revised from time to time.

Upward revision of insurance charges, if any, will be done on your policy anniversary and we will notify you in writing at least 30 days before the revision takes place. Any revision will aim to reflect factors such as our claim experience, cost of medical treatment, advancements in medical technology, or other justified circumstances. These changes will apply to all policies, regardless of individual claim history.

25. How are health loadings and/or exclusions applied to GMVE?

Any latest health loadings and/or exclusions imposed on your Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) will be applied to your new GMVE rider.

26. Can I appeal on the health loadings and/or exclusions applied in SPYE + GMVE under this Campaign?

No, appeals cannot be made under this Campaign. Any request for review can be submitted after the new SPYE + GMVE has been in force.

27. Can the Proposer of the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) and the new SPYE + GMVE be different persons?

Yes, the proposer for the new SPYE + GMVE can be different from the proposer of the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s).

28. If my Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) has lapsed during the Campaign period, can I still proceed with the application?

Yes, you may proceed to apply for the new policy as long as your Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) is reinstated during the Campaign period before you proceed with the application request. However, this Campaign offer will be voided if the underwriting decision upon reinstatement reveals any substandard conditions that fall outside the Company's acceptable risk parameters.

29. I have received the offer letter for this Campaign. However, the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) has been upgraded / converted to another medical plan. Can I still proceed with the application?

Yes, you can still proceed with the application for the new SPYE + GMVE, provided the upgraded / converted medical plan is in force.

However, please note that if the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) has been upgraded / converted to GREAT MediValue (GMV), the application for SPYE + GMVE will be declined. This is because only one (1) GMV / GMVE policy per life is allowed.

To proceed with the application for SPYE + GMVE, the existing GMV policy must be terminated, and the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) is successfully reinstated.

30. I have been selected for this Campaign but discovered a new medical condition before applying for SPYE + GMVE under this Campaign during the offer period, can I still proceed with the application?

Yes, you can proceed to apply for the new policy under this Campaign during the offer period as long as you fulfill the terms and conditions of the Campaign. Please refer to the terms and conditions in the policy documents of SPYE and GMVE for detailed exclusions regarding pre-existing coverage under the policy.

31. How do I know if my application has been successfully processed?

The Company will issue an endorsement and policy documents of the new policy once it is in force.

32. Can I cancel my application after it has been processed?

Yes, you may cancel your new policy within the free look period, which is 15 calendar days after the new policy has been delivered to you. The Company will refund to you the unallocated premiums, the value of the units that have been allocated (if any) at unit price at the next valuation date and any insurance charge and policy fee that have been deducted.

Policy Servicing

33. Can I opt for different medical rider or choose a different deductible or higher annual limit option which is different from what is offered?

No, you can only apply for the new plan as advised by your servicing agent or the Company (refer to Question 1 above). If you wish to opt for a different medical rider, deductible option or higher annual limit, you may apply for your preferred option during the proposal stage (New Business stage). Alternatively, if you have already proceeded with the plan offered under this Campaign and later decide to make changes, you may amend the benefits after the new policy is in force (Customer Service stage).

New Business stage:

To purchase GREAT MediValue via the usual enrolment process through your servicing agent. Medical underwriting will be required, and standard waiting period shall apply.

Customer Service stage:

To switch to a different medical rider / other deductible option / higher annual limit after the new SPYE + GMVE plan is in force, you need to complete and submit “Request for Contractual Changes With Health Declaration Form (PSF02)” along with the “ILP Request for Alteration” form. Full medical underwriting is required if the alteration is to upgrade the benefits, such as reducing deductible from RM20,000 to RM500 and so on. Standard waiting period shall apply. Please contact your servicing agent or the Company for assistance.

34. Can I increase the basic sum assured of SPYE to a higher amount?

No, as this is a guaranteed issuance offer Campaign, the basic sum assured for SPYE is fixed at RM6,000 and cannot be increased or decreased.

35. Can I add on other riders to the new policy?

No, as this is a guaranteed issuance offer Campaign, Selected Customers can only apply for SPYE + GMVE (whichever is applicable). If you are interested in adding other rider(s), you can contact your servicing agent or the Company for assistance. Please note that any changes will be subject to the standard underwriting process and standard waiting period for other newly added riders shall apply.

36. Can I reinstate my SPYE + GMVE?

Yes, you can reinstate your SPYE + GMVE and will be subject to the standard underwriting process. Please note that the waiting period and exclusions on pre-existing coverage shall be applied again from the reinstatement date if there is a break in coverage subsequent to the risk commencement date of GMVE.

Medical Claims

37. Once the new SPYE + GMVE is in force, how do I utilise both the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) and the new policy in a single medical claim event?

You may utilise either the Existing Medical Plan(s)/rider(s) or the new policy for admission provided the disability is eligible to both plans/riders.

Utilising Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) first

Once the limit under the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) has been fully utilised, you may continue claiming any remaining eligible expenses under the new SPYE + GMVE without the need to pay and later request reimbursement for the deductible and/or co-insurance (if applicable) upon discharge. GMVE’s coverage will be subject to the benefit’s limits, terms and conditions of The Great Journey pathway and exclusions on the pre-existing coverage.

Items claimed under the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) will be automatically deemed as fulfilling the deductible and/or co-insurance (if applicable) of the new SPYE + GMVE, if those items are eligible for such deductible and/or co-insurance under GMVE.

Please note that claims under the new SPYE + GMVE will be subject to standard review process. Letter of Guarantee will be rejected if investigation is required to rule out pre-existing illness or if the admitting disability is not eligible under GMVE.

Utilising new GMVE first

If you wish to utilise the benefit under the new SPYE + GMVE first, the deductible and co-insurance (if applicable) will be automatically claimed under the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Riders(s). GMVE’s coverage will be subject to the GMVE deductible amount, the applicable benefit limits, the terms and conditions of The Great Journey pathway and the exclusions relating to pre-existing conditions.

However, please note that the claim and discharge process may take longer, as we need to review and process your claim across both your Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) and the new SPYE + GMVE. If you do not wish for the deductible and/co-insurance (if applicable) to be claimed under the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s), please inform the hospital/our Medical Claims department so that your claim can be processed without using both plans together.

You may refer to Question 38 and Appendix below for some claims scenarios.

38. I have an existing medical plan(s)/rider(s) or medical plan from other companies. How can that be used to offset the deductible amount of this new GMVE?

If you utilise your existing medical plan(s)/rider(s) or medical plan from other companies for admission first, and subsequently wishes to claim under GMVE, the hospital must be able to provide the bills submitted to the other companies, the diagnosis and the relevant medical evidence to our Medical Claims Department when applying for Letter of Guarantee (GL).

Processing GL issuance may take longer time, as the Company will need to conduct additional assessment to ensure that the items claimed under other companies are eligible under the new GMVE.

Once the deductible and/or co-insurance is considered fulfilled, eligible items claimed under GMVE will not be subject to deductible and/or co-insurance. This process requires cooperation from the hospital and will be arranged on a best effort basis.

You may choose to pay first to proceed with treatment or discharge from the hospital and subsequently submit a reimbursement claim to the Company for eligible items.

39. What happens if my Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) is undergoing a claim process? Can I still apply for the SPYE + GMVE under this Campaign during the offer period, and how will the claims be paid?

If your Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) is eligible and fulfills all the terms and conditions of the Campaign during the offer period, you can proceed with the application for the new policy even if there is an ongoing claim process under the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s). You may continue to submit any claims under your Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) as usual. For the new policy, claims can only be submitted after the new policy has been issued and is in force. Claim submission will be subject to standard review process.

40. Is cashless facility applicable for the new policy of SPYE + GMVE?

Yes, cashless facility is applicable, subject to verification and terms and conditions of The Great Journey pathway.

41. If I was previously diagnosed with a disability or medical condition related to 50 critical illnesses, spinal disorders or diabetes and its complication or any other pre-existing conditions (refer to pre-existing illness or any other pre-existing conditions under Question 1 above) before the GMVE risk commencement date, and is later diagnosed with a new disability or medical condition related to the pre-existing illness or any other pre-existing conditions after GMVE's risk commencement date, can the new disability or medical condition be claimed under new GMVE?

If the newly diagnosed disability or medical condition related to the pre-existing illness or any other pre-existing conditions is a separate diagnosis and not a progression of the previous diagnosis, and is supported by medical evidence, it is claimable under new GMVE.

42. If I was first diagnosed with one of the twelve (12) covered outpatient disability conditions before the new policy's risk commencement date, and is diagnosed again after the policy is in force, can I claim within the 3-year coverage period?

Yes, the twelve (12) covered outpatient disabilities is considered as minor conditions, you are eligible to claim for outpatient treatment immediately once the policy is in force.

- (a) *Pre-existing illness – disabilities or conditions related to 50 critical illnesses (refer to Question 1 above), spinal disorders, or diabetes and its complications that have been diagnosed, disclosed, or claimed prior to the risk effective date of the new policy will **not** be covered.*
- (b) *For other pre-existing conditions (not listed in (a) above), coverage will be **excluded**:*
- *if the conditions have been diagnosed, disclosed, or claimed prior to the risk effective date of the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s); and*
 - *for the first 3 policy years commencing from the risk effective date of the new policy where such conditions have been diagnosed, disclosed or claimed at any time from the risk effective date of the Existing Medical Plan(s)/Rider(s) up to the risk effective date of the new policy. Coverage for these conditions shall commence from the 4th policy year onwards.*
- (c) *If there is a break in coverage after the risk effective date of GMVE, the same terms and conditions for pre-existing conditions as stated in (a) and (b) above will apply again from the reinstatement date, which shall be deemed the risk effective date of the new policy for this purpose.*
