Raised by a single parent, Netiswaran worked at Great Eastern as a data entry clerk while freelancing in video editing. He alongside fellow scholarship recipient, Nur Adila Lieow will further their studies in computer science and marketing respectively in Universiti Teknologi Malaysia.

From the 15 scholarships being awarded, 10 recipients will be attending local public universities while four selected students will further their education in local private universities. Ler Wei Han is the only scholarship recipient who will be pursuing actuarial science in University of Warwick, United Kingdom.

Dato Koh Yaw Hui said, "The Supremacy Scholarship has been a platform for deserving young Malaysians to realise their potential and contribute towards elevating the country to a developed-nation status by vision 2020. Apart from driving the progress of our country, they could also be the answer to skill shortage issues faced across the industry.
