50 DESERVING CHILDREN RECEIVE RM10,800 FROM PROGRAM ASPIRASI GEMILANG 'A'

First CSR initiative by an insurance company to award deserving children for every 'A' achieved in exam

Kuala Lumpur – 50 deserving children from welfare homes today receive cash award of RM100 from Great Eastern Life Assurance (Malaysia) Berhad (Great Eastern Life) for each 'A' they achieved in national examinations namely UPSR, PMR and SPM held last year through their Program Aspirasi Gemilang 'A', the first CSR initiative of its kind by a life insurance company.

Dato' Sri Rohani Abdul Karim, Minister of Woman, Family and Community Development together with Dato Koh Yaw Hui, Director and Chief Executive Officer of Great Eastern Life present the cash award amounting RM10,800 to the 50 children who came from 43 different children homes registered with the Department of Social Welfare Malaysia at an award presentation ceremony here at 1 Utama Shopping Centre.

"Great Eastern Life ChildrenCare launched the Program Aspirasi Gemilang 'A' initiative in August last year which benefitted close to 500 school children who received reference books, workbooks and stationeries from us to aid them in their preparation for the national examinations. Today, we will be rewarding 50 dedicated students who worked extremely hard to obtain 108 'As' in their national examinations last year," says Dato Koh Yaw Hui.

"I'm very pleased to announce that this year's results saw a 100 percent improvement in the number of 'As' achieved by the students compared to 2012, where 53 'As' were achieved by 30 students. A special mention to Delaksina and Hamidah who have both achieved 4 'As' respectively in UPSR, Amizah who has achieved 5 'As' in PMR and to top it off, Nurul Ain who has achieved 10 'As' in SPM, these are the top students in their respective examinations and we are extremely proud of their outstanding achievements," he continues.

Dato' Sri Rohani Abdul Karim lauded Great Eastern Life's corporate social responsibility effort, she says "this strategic partnership between Department of Social Welfare Malaysia (JKM) and Great Eastern Life is to encourage and motivate children from the JKM institutions to excel in

their studies. I hope that this long term programme will continue to inspire more children in their pursuit of success."

In conjunction with the award presentation ceremony, Great Eastern Life ChildrenCare has also organised the 'Live Great Discovery' from 9 to 13 April. In line with the 3 core pillars of Great Eastern Life ChildrenCare, 'Live Great Discovery' aimed to inspire children with the possibilities in life and help discover their true potential in the areas of education, health and wellness and personal development.

At the "Education" corner, children will learn about using the C Programming Language to control robots, which will stimulate their understanding in the subjects like Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) and improve their lateral thinking, communications and problem-solving skills.

To prevent prevailing health conditions among children, there are few complimentary health checks available at the "Health and Wellness" corner, such as the lazy eye check and BMI test to ensure that the children are not hindered by an impaired vision or obesity in their journey to discover their true potential. Over at the "Personal Development" corner, children can also express their creativity through Lego building and clay craft making activities.

On top of these three dedicated corners, children can also increase their motor and communication skills at the 'Fun Zone' by partaking in 10 of the sporty and fun activities such as rock climbing, soccer, basket ball with the purchase of a 1-Day pass at RM20. "All proceeds will be channeled to children homes under the umbrella of the Department of Social Welfare Malaysia through the ChildrenCare fund, which will be used to benefit underprivileged children. To date, Great Eastern Life ChildrenCare has donated more than RM1.9 million to over 180 children homes in Malaysia since 1995," added Dato Koh Yaw Hui during the launch event.
