

Contest Terms & Conditions

1. The Colour Me Up! 2018 Colouring Contest ("Contest") is organised by Great Eastern Life Assurance (Malaysia) Berhad (93745-A) ("The Organiser") and is only open to all Malaysians aged seven (7) to twelve (12) years ("Contestant") and all primary schools nationwide ("School"), except all children of employees (permanent, temporary or on contract basis) of the Organiser.
2. This Contest runs from 21 May 2018 to 15 August 2018 ("Contest Period"). Entries received after 15 August 2018 will not be considered.
3. Contest Mechanics:-
 - 3.1. Draw and colour/complete the picture in Contest entry form by using colour pencils, markers, crayons and other colouring tools.
 - 3.2. Contestants are to complete the slogan, "I feel happy when I travel with my family because" in not more than 20 words.
 - 3.3. Each Contestant may submit more than one (1) entry. However, each Contestant is limited to one (1) prize per person.
 - 3.4. Judging criteria
 - 3.4.1 Contestant
Entries for Contestants will be judged on the basis of creativity of colouring, drawing and slogan.
 - 3.4.2 School
School winners will be determined based on the highest participation ratio, i.e. total complete participation divide by total number of Contestants in the school.
 - 3.5. All the Contest entry forms must be completed in full and signed by a parent or legal guardian. The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify entries with invalid or incomplete details.

8. Contestants may add drawings on the colouring section but it must not contain copyrighted work. Any colouring tools may be used, including but not limited to colour pencils and crayons.
9. Contestants must complete the colouring Contest together with the slogan by themselves without assistance from a third party.
10. The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify entries (at any stage of the Contest) that do not meet the Contest mechanics and/or with invalid or incomplete details. All decisions made

by the Organiser are final and the disqualified Contestant -or School will accordingly have no recourse and/or remedy and/or relief against the Organiser in respect of the said disqualification and/or in respect of any matters relating to and/or arising from this Contest, including the withdrawal of Prizes.
