



Colour Me Up! 2019 ***Contest Terms & Conditions***

1. The Colour Me Up! 2019 Colouring Contest (“Contest”) is organised by Great Eastern Life Assurance (Malaysia) Berhad (93745-A) (“Organiser”) and is only open to all Malaysian nationals aged between seven (7) to twelve (12) years (“Contestant(s)”) and to all national primary schools nationwide (“School(s)”), except all children of employees (permanent, temporary or on contract basis) of the Organiser.
2. This Contest runs from 10th June 2019 till 30th August 2019 (“Contest Period”). Entries received on or after 31st August 2019 will not be entertained.
3. The Contest mechanics are as follows:
 - 3.1. Contestant(s) are to draw and colour/complete the picture in the Contest entry form by using colouring tools.
 - 3.2. Contestant(s) are to complete the slogan, “If I was a superhero, I would...” in not more than 20 words.
 - 3.3. Each Contestant may submit more than one (1) entry. However, each Contestant is limited to one (1) Prize per person.
 - 3.4. Judging criteria
 - 3.4.1. Contestant(s)
Entries for each Contestant will be judged on the basis of creativity on colouring, drawing and slogan completion.
 - 3.4.2. School(s)
School winners will be determined based on the highest participation ratio, i.e. total complete participation divided by total number of students in the school. Should the participation ratio be equal for 2 or more schools, the date of receipt will be used as the deciding factor (the earlier submission wins).
 - 3.5. All the Contest entry forms must be completed in full and signed by a parent or legal guardian. The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify entries with invalid or incomplete details.

 - 3.7. All entries must be received by the Organiser on or before 30th August 2019 (“Closing Date”).
4. Photocopies of the Contest entry forms are acceptable.
5. Proof of delivery of the entry shall NOT be deemed as proof of receipt by the Organiser.
6. The Organiser shall not be liable or responsible for any delay and/or failure in the receipt of the entry.
7. The Organiser is not liable or responsible for any late, lost, incomplete, incorrectly submitted, delayed or misdirected entries.



8. Contestant(s) may add additional drawings in the colouring section but it must not contain copyrighted work and must be of an original content/creativity. Any colouring tools may be used, including but not limited to colour pencils, crayons, markers, and watercolours.
9. Contestant(s) must complete the colouring and slogan portions of the Contest entry form by themselves without the assistance from any third party(ies).
10. The Organiser reserves the right to disqualify entries (at any stage of the Contest) that do not meet the Contest mechanics and/or have invalid or incomplete details. All decisions made by the Organiser are final and the disqualified Contestant(s) or School(s) will accordingly have no recourse and/or remedy and/or relief against the Organiser in respect of the said disqualification and/or in respect of any matters relating to and/or arising from this Contest, including the forfeiture of Prizes.
11. All entries shall become the absolute property of the Organiser and will not be returned to the Contestant(s).
12. Winners will be announced through Great Eastern Life Malaysia website (<https://www.greasternlife.com>) and/or through phone notification or whichever mode deemed appropriate by the Organiser. If despite all reasonable efforts the Organiser is unable to locate or contact the winner(s), another winner will be selected.
13. All Prizes must be claimed within four (4) months after the winners have been successfully contacted. Failure to claim Prizes shall result in the Prizes automatically being forfeited, and the Organiser, its agents and representatives shall have no liability to the winners in any aspect whatsoever.
14. All decisions made by the Organiser in relation to this Contest including but not limited to the selection of winners and forfeiture of Prizes (if any) shall be final, conclusive and binding. No correspondence or appeals will be entertained. 17. The Organiser assumes no responsibility or liability for any damage, loss, harm or injuries resulting from the acceptance or use of any Prizes.
18. Pictures of the Prizes shown in materials related to this Contest are solely for illustration purposes only and may not depict the actual colour, model or specifications of the Prizes and do not include any optional accessories unless otherwise stated.
19. The Organiser reserves the right to use, disclose and publish any of the particulars/pictures/artwork of the Contestants or winners of the Contest, or other personal particulars of them or their parent(s)/legal guardian(s) for any legitimate purpose as deemed appropriate including but not limited to advertising and publicity purposes, without compensation to the winners (or where applicable, their authorised representatives). The winners or their duly authorised representatives may be required to attend prize presentations and/or participate in publicity programmes, which the Organiser may from time to time organise in connection with the Contest and if so, such winner(s) or their duly authorised representatives should attend such functions at their own cost and expense.

The submission of all entries must not contain copyrighted work and in the event it is found that an entry has breached this regulation, the said breach shall result in the disqualification of the submission of entry of the Contestant(s) at the sole discretion of the Organiser (or where applicable, their authorised representatives).
21. If for any reason any aspect of this Contest is not capable of running as planned, the Organiser reserves the right to amend, postpone or cancel the Contest at its absolute discretion.

By participating in the Contest, the parents or guardians of the Contestant provides his/her consent to the Organiser processing his/her as well as the Contestant's personal data, which includes but is not limited to their name, contact number and address in the manner set out in the PDP Notice and permits the Organiser or authorised representatives to contact the parents or guardians of the Contestant(s) regarding the Contest and delivery of Prizes of this Contest.
23. By participating in this Contest, all parents or guardians of Contestants warrant that all statements and personal details given are true, accurate and complete. The respective parties are also taken to have read, understood and agreed to be bound by these Terms and Conditions, and accept all decisions by the Organiser as final and binding.
